What is Dodge Xtreme Bulls?

Dodge Xtreme Bulls, presented by B&W Trailer Hitches, showcases the PRCA's top bull riders and some of the rankest bulls the world has to offer. The 10-stop Tour is managed, licensed and marketed by Winnercomm Sports of Tulsa, Okla., and is being televised on ESPN and ESPN2.

The pool of bull riders for the Tour includes the top cowboys from the ProRodeo Cowboys World Standings, as well as contestants who qualify through the Dodge Xtreme Bulls qualifying events.

In Xtreme Bulls, every contestant competes in the first round, with the top performers advancing to the final round. The winner of the two-head average wins that stop's title. Money won on the Dodge Xtreme Bulls Tour will count toward the ProRodeo Cowboys World

Standings, which helps to determine the qualifiers for the Wrangler NFR in Las Vegas.

In 2007, Kanin Asay of Powell, Wyo., took home the Xtreme Bulls championship after earning \$72,133 during the 10-venue season. Highlights of the 2007 Dodge Xtreme Bulls Tour included a pair of big paydays for Wesley Silcox in Reno, Nev., and Ellensburg, Wash., that ultimately played a integral role in winning his first world bull riding title; two Tour-round victories by a pair of world champions in B.J. Schumacher (2006) and Cody Hancock (2000); and an infusion of young talent, headlined by season champion Asay and Chance Smart, who won the Tour-stop title in Houston.
