What is Xtreme Bulls?



The Seminole Hard Rock Xtreme Bulls Tour, presented by B&W Trailer Hitches, showcases the PRCA's top bull riders and some of the rankest bulls the world has to offer. Xtreme Bulls events include a 10-stop Xtreme Bulls Tour that is telecast by Great American Country on Dish Network's channel 167 and DirecTV's channel 326.

The pool of bull riders for the Tour includes the top bull riders from the PRCA World Standings as well as contestants who advance through Xtreme Bulls qualifying events.

In Xtreme Bulls events, every contestant competes in the first round, with the top performers advancing to the final round. The winner of the two-head average after the final round wins that event's title. Money won on the Xtreme Bulls Tour counts toward the PRCA World Standings for bull riding, which determine the qualifiers for the Wrangler National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas.

Xtreme Bulls leader Wesley Silcox was dumped by his first bull in the 2010 Finale, but his \$37,758 in Tour earnings held up to give him his first Tour season championship. Silcox's championship was the product of steady earnings; he did not win any Tour stops, but he placed at three, winning the final round at San Antonio-Feb. 4. For the second year in a row, and only third overall, no cowboy won more than one Tour stop.

The 2010 Finale was won by D.J. Domangue in his best rodeo to date; he picked up a whopping \$21,094 in Ellensburg with back-to-back 90-point rides, a mittful of money which boosted him from 16th to 6th in the PRCA World Standings and up to fifth in the Seminole Hard Rock Xtreme Bulls Tour standings. Domangue's final ride capped an outstanding final round which saw six scores of 88 points or better, led by Bobby Welsh's 92.5.
